It wasn't a gradual change from light to super high winds. It came POW. The RC boat's anchor dragged when Plurabelle and Ice-Nine were finishing (luckily Plurabelle noted their elapsed time on their instruments) and then the RC boat's engine wouldn't start. They were rafted up to the pin boat & used it to tow them back to the line for reanchoring.

During a gybe, Madeleine Kiss fell off Loki & into the water; Loki did a 720 and picked her up.

When the wind changed Atlas had a big round-up (almost knock down) and headed toward the BW. When they got to the finish, the RC was gone, but they knew they finished 1 min. and 30 seconds after Bellatrix.

The 2 RAF's were due to confusion as to which way to round "C" the 2nd time. The RC correctly put up "Charlie" and changed all roundings to starboard and then switched the 2nd time at "C" to be "to port" (at the request of one of the race boats) while "Charlie" was still raised, made the announcement on the radio, but didn't do a sound or 2nd raising. The RC regrets the confusion to the fleet.
